## Medical Information

Hemodialysis campers will be transported to a hemodialysis center in Flint for dialysis during camp week. Medical personnel will be in residence at camp throughout the entire week, 24 hours a day. Nurses accompany hemodialysis campers to dialysis, assist with CAPD exchanges, and dispense medications to all campers.
